GENERAL

YONEX German Junior 2022 is part of the World Junior Ranking 2022 and the Badminton Europe Junior Circuit 2022.

The tournament will be played in accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the General Competition regulations of BWF as well as with the Badminton Europe Junior Circuit Regulations.

ELIGIBILITY

1. German players must have a legal playing certificate.
 2. Foreign players have to be members of an association affiliated to the BWF.
 3. Open for players according to the current Badminton Europe-/ BWF-age-limit (born on or after 1 January 2004).

ENTRIES

Each player is allowed to play in 3 events.

The amount of entries which can be accepted in each event are:

128 in Men's and Women's singles

64 in Men's & Women's doubles

96 in Mixed doubles

If the amount of entries exceeds the amount listed above, a selection of entries will be made in accordance with regulation 6.1.5 of the Badminton Europe Junior Circuit Regulations.

Entries must be done in order of strength and must include the date of birth.

It is required that every event in a particular BEC Junior Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors and at In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

ONLINE-ENTRY

All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System.

Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number, please contact the BWF office well in advance of the tournament, so that the players concerned can get a BWF ID-number before the closing date of the tournament.

Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday 8 February 2022 at 23.59 hours BWF Headquarter time (GMT + 08.00 hours). You are required to submit the entries on time and late entries will not be accepted.

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

German Badminton Association is not allowed to accept any late entries so it is imperative that entries are submitted on time in the Online Entry System.

ENTRY FEE

Singles 30 EUR
Doubles 22 EUR per competitor

The Member Association that enters a player/pair into YONEX German Junior 2022 is responsible for paying the entry fee for that player/pair. Each Member association will receive one invoice with the total of entered players. It is not possible single players pay separately. The entry fee becomes due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.

You will receive an invoice for your payment when the draw is conducted.

ACCREDITATION

The organiser will provide all players and team officials with accreditation cards. All associations and German county regional teams as well as clubs are asked to complete the **accreditation form** and send it back to thomas.lohwieser@badminton.de **before 28th February 2022**. Accreditation cards will only be provided for players, coaches, physiotherapists and official team-members.

It is mandatory to present this accreditation card when entering the venue. It will be not possible to enter the venue without accreditation card.

The accreditation cards will be handed out at the team Managers Meeting. If a team cannot participate in the team managers meeting (for example due to late arrival), the cards must be picked up on Wednesday (first day of competition) at the entry to the venue (preferred as team package). If someone is coming on his own she/he must present an official ID-card.

DOPING CONTROL

According to German anti-doping law doping control may be carried out on a random basis at any time.

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

BADMINTON INTEGRITY

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
